

Ref.2 Sendai Framework for DRR 2015-2030

Expected outcome (paragraph16)

The substantial reduction of disaster risk and losses in lives, livelihoods and health and in the economic, physical, social, cultural and environmental assets of persons, businesses, communities and countries

Goal (paragraph17)

Prevent new and reduce existing disaster risk through the implementation of integrated and inclusive economic, structural, legal, social, health, cultural, educational, environmental, technological, political and institutional measures that prevent and reduce hazard exposure and vulnerability to disaster, increase preparedness for response and recovery, and thus strengthen resilience

Seven global targets (paragraph18)

1. A substantial reduction in global disaster mortality;
2. A substantial reduction in numbers of affected people;
3. A reduction in economic loss in relation to global gross domestic product (GDP);
4. Substantial reduction in disaster damage to critical infrastructure and disruption of basic services, including health and educational facilities;
5. An increase in the number of countries with national and local disaster risk reduction strategies;
6. Enhanced international cooperation;
7. Increased access to multi-hazard early warning systems and disaster risk information and assessments.

Four priorities for action (Paragraph 20)

1. Understanding disaster risk (paragraphs 23-25);
2. Strengthening disaster risk governance to manage disaster risk (paragraphs 26-28);
3. Investment in disaster risk reduction for resilience (paragraphs 29-31);
4. Enhancing disaster preparedness for effective response, and to “Build Back Better” in recovery, rehabilitation and reconstruction (paragraphs 32-34)
